Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope that you are all keeping safe and well as we all begin to move to something which feels a little bit more like our old lives. I've had a couple of conversations with parents this week who have talked about how much they have enjoyed spending more time with their children. This is so lovely to hear. In the rush of our busy lives it can sometimes be hard to juggle work and home and maybe the one thing we can take from this awful time is that it allowed parents and children to spend precious time together. Make the most of it - they grow up far too quickly!

We have had more children in school this week which has been lovely. They have all been amazing and have adapted to the new rules and routines very quickly. As the situation in Doncaster remains unchanged, we are continuing with our plans to invite more pupils from Reception, Year1 and Nursery into school over the remaining weeks.

Parents of children due to join Reception and Nursery in September have been contacted regarding transition and I am aware that all pupils in Year 6 will have received a transition pack from the Local Authority.

The teachers from all year groups have been posting video messages on the blog this week so please take a look.

It is our intention for school to be closed in the summer holiday period. We will close for the Year 6, Year 1, Reception and Nursery groups on Tuesday 14th July and will close for Key worker groups on Friday 17th July. We will reopen for pupils on Thursday 3rd September. The Local Authority is planning a program of borough-wide activities and events that children can access during the summer and as soon as we know more details about this we will share them with you.

As the national and local picture looks more promising we are hopeful that school will be able to open for all pupils in September and we are planning towards this. We are also developing a range of contingency plans should government guidance and the local context indicate the need for some flexibility.
